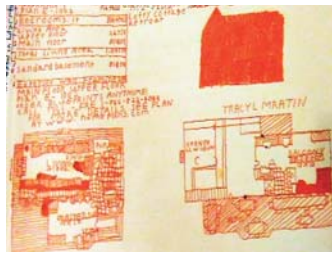

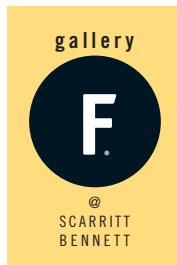

This show attempts to shed light on the relationship between the artistic process and the product. In this case the product is very colorful, joyful and pure. The intentions are not to resolve the problems of the world, but to convey more basic needs, like living in a house, having my cat, being with a friend.

In the end it does not matter if we call it Raw Art, Art Brut, or Outsider Art - we all become Insiders.
