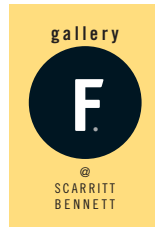


NATIVE

Native presents five unexpected artistic perspectives on Native North American culture. Through photography, painting, indoor and outdoor installation, and performance video, artists ranging in age from 24- to 72-years-old portray their connections with the Choctaw, Ojibwe, Zapotec, Cherokee, Kiowa, Wichita and Chickasaw tribes. Traditional assumptions about native art are simultaneously validated and destroyed, as the pieces in this exhibition pay homage to native culture while departing from traditional native artistic expression.
