The *Elders for Today Conference* will bring together people who experienced the Civil Rights era of the 1960s and those interested in learning about the era, and engage them in an interactive conversation about civil rights and social justice issues past and present.

The conference will provide participants with a historical perspective of the movement using Nashville's Civil Rights history as a spring-board. A variety of creative methods for the sharing of individual memories and experiences will include music, writing, technology and art; and will encourage participants to explore how the Civil Rights Movement of the 1960s continues to impact America today, and what it might mean for tomorrow.
