KEYNOTE SPEAKER: DR. KWASI KENA

The Rev. Dr. Kwasi Kena is the Director of Evangelism Resources at the General Board of Discipleship and a clergy member of the Greater New Jersey Annual Conference. He received a B.S. in business administration and management from Bradley University, a B.M. in piano performance from Wisconsin College Conservatory of Music, a M. Div. from Oral Roberts University and a D. Min in Afrocentric pastoring and preaching from United Theological Seminary. Rev. Kena is an elder in the Greater New Jersey Annual Conference, where he served as the Congregational Development Coordinator. Prior to his present position, he served as the Field Services Director and General Editor at the General Commission on United Methodist Men. He has also served as a General Board of Global Ministries (GBGM) commissioned missionary to Ghana West Africa and a Missionary in Residence with GBGM in New York City. Rev. Kena is married to the Rev. Dr. Safiyah Fosua. The couple has two sons and two adorable grandchildren.

Sara has been a staff member at First United Methodist Church in Lawrence, Kansas for 12 years and currently serves as the Director of Worship and Music Ministries. She is a member of a worship design subcommittee of the Kansas East Conference. Sara received her bachelor's degree in organ and sacred music from Baker University in Baldwin City, Kansas and her master's degree in choral conducting from the University of Kansas.

Carlton E. Maaia II was the 2010-2011 Musician-in-Residence at the Scarritt-Bennett Center in Nashville, Tennessee, where he helped begin Vespers and All That Jazz. He continues to arrange and supervise the music for that program from his home in Berkshire County, Massachusetts. He is the Minister of Music at First Church of Christ, Congregational in Pittsfield, Massachusetts and is the Artistic Director of The Berkshire Concert Choir. He has music-directed productions at The Berkshire Theatre Festival since 2005 and has also taught for Barrington Stage Company. He was the Fine Arts Coordinator at Memorial United Methodist Church in White Plains, New York from 2005-2010 and was Director of Music at St. Mark's Church in Pittsfield from 2002-2005.
